The BEREC MTS has the function of guiding BEREC's work in the medium term and serves as the blue print for BEREC´s annual work programmes.

BEREC has today published for consultation on broad and open questions concerning the review of the <u>draft BEREC Medium-Term Strategy for 2018-2020</u>. In the first section of this consultation BEREC seeks open inputs on which market and technological developments could influence the new strategy, while also seeking answers to questions on more specific areas, such as the enduser experience, competitive dynamics in digital markets and the evolution of networks.
